

# RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BAILDON NO. 131

## BYLAW NO. 09-2014

### A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE SPEED OF VEHICLES EXCEEDING GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHTS OF 10 TONNE.

THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BAILDON NO. 131, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Overweight Vehicle Speed Restriction Bylaw".
2. In this bylaw the expression:
  - a) "Public Highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highways and Transportation Act, 1997, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such act
  - b) "Vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highways and Transportation Act, 1997
  - c) "Gross Vehicle Weight" shall mean the prescribed or ordered weight as determined by the vehicle registration as issued by Saskatchewan Government Insurance.
3. A person operating a vehicle with a Gross Vehicle Weight exceeding 10 tonnes shall not travel at a speed greater than 70 kilometers per hour on all roads owned and operated by the Rural Municipality of Baildon No. 131.
4. Signs indicating both the speed and the Gross Vehicle Weight restriction to which the speed limitation applies shall be erected on all roads owned and operated by the Rural Municipality of Baildon No. 131 that enter the Rural Municipality of Baildon No. 131 and all roads owned and operated by the Rural Municipality of Baildon No. 131 that arterial off of Highway No. 2.
5. Any person who contravenes any of the portions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on date of approval being issued by the Highway Traffic Board of Saskatchewan.
